

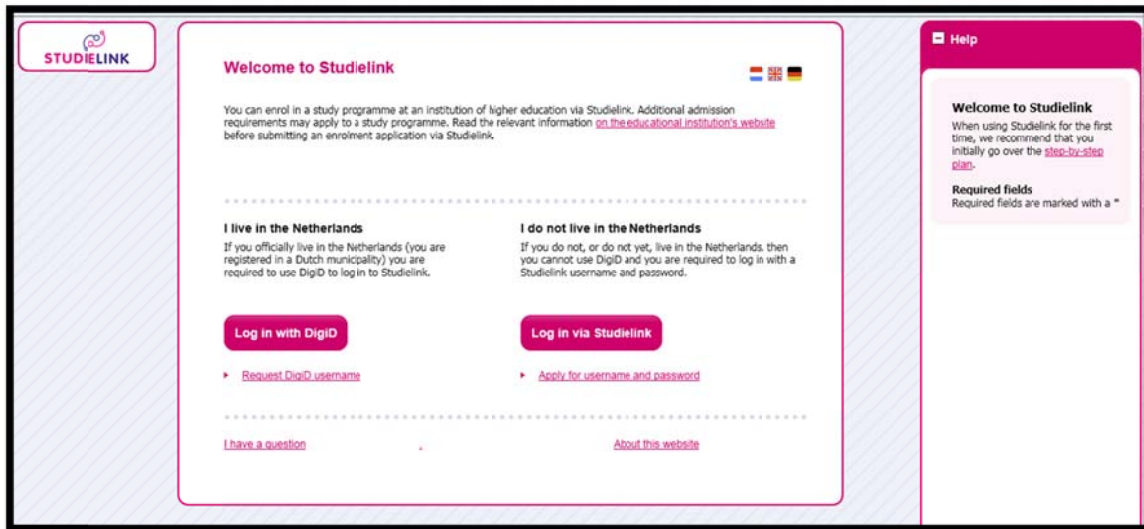

How to add your previous education in Studielink (non-Dutch diploma's)

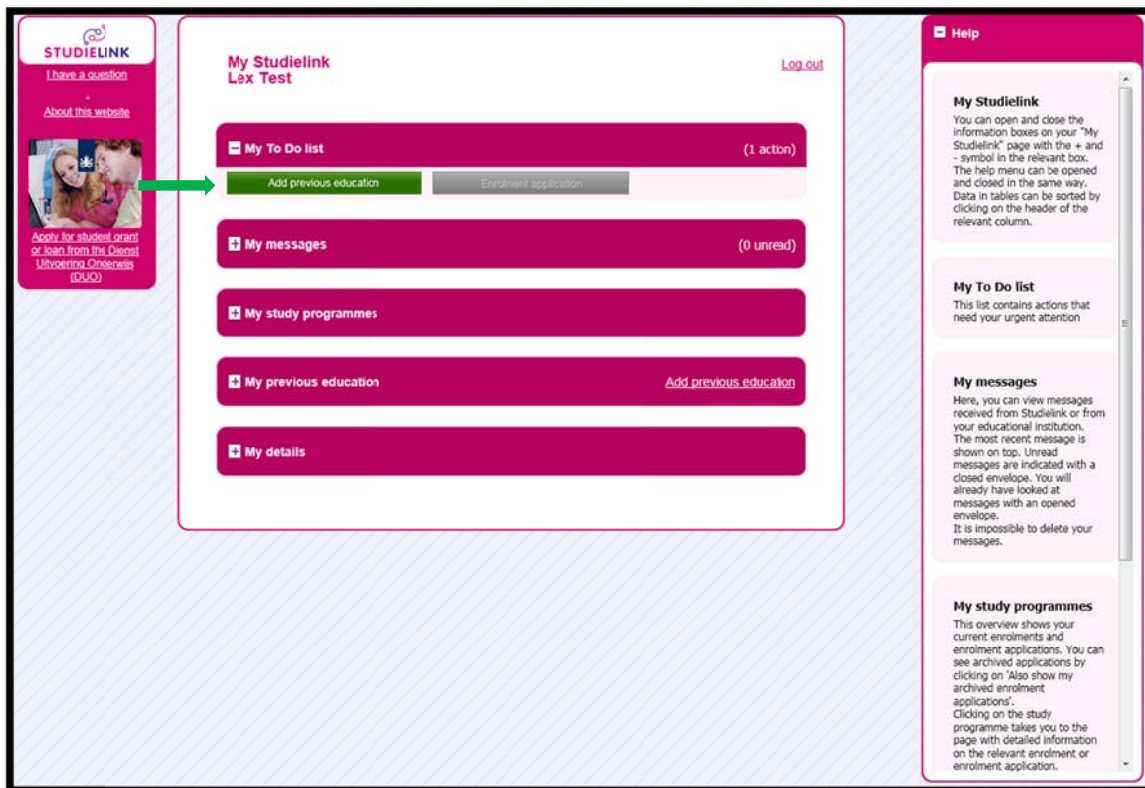
How to add a previous education

Before you make an enrolment application, you need to add a previous education.

- Log in to Studielink with your DigiD (for students with a Dutch address), or via Studielink (for students with a foreign address).



- Click on the <Add previous education> button under <My To Do List> or use the <Add previous education> link under <My previous education>.



- Indicate whether you have obtained or have yet to obtain your diploma.
- Select the country where you obtained or will obtain the diploma.
- Select the applicable diploma. If your diploma is not in the list, you can enter the name of the programme manually under <Other>.
