Why do we organize The Hague Matching Days?

Dear prospective students,

Congratulations on enrolling for the International Business programme at The Hague University of Applied Sciences. Preparatory Assignment

How do I hand in the assignment?

Upload the assignment as pdf document in Osiris. Please write down your name and student number on it. You can log in to Osiris Registration. When you signed up in Studielink, you have received an e-mail with your student number, your log in information and the link to Osiris Registration.

After logging in you can see the programmes you are enrolled for. Select The Hague Matching Days 2019 for the programme you want to hand in the assignment and click 'further'. Answer the questions on the screen, upload the assignment and send it in. You will receive a confirmation automatically by e-mail.
