Google Scholar

Google Scholar (<http://scholar.google.com>) is a very useful tool for finding scientific and scholarly articles. It allows you to set your preferences so that **Find it** is added to the list of search results.

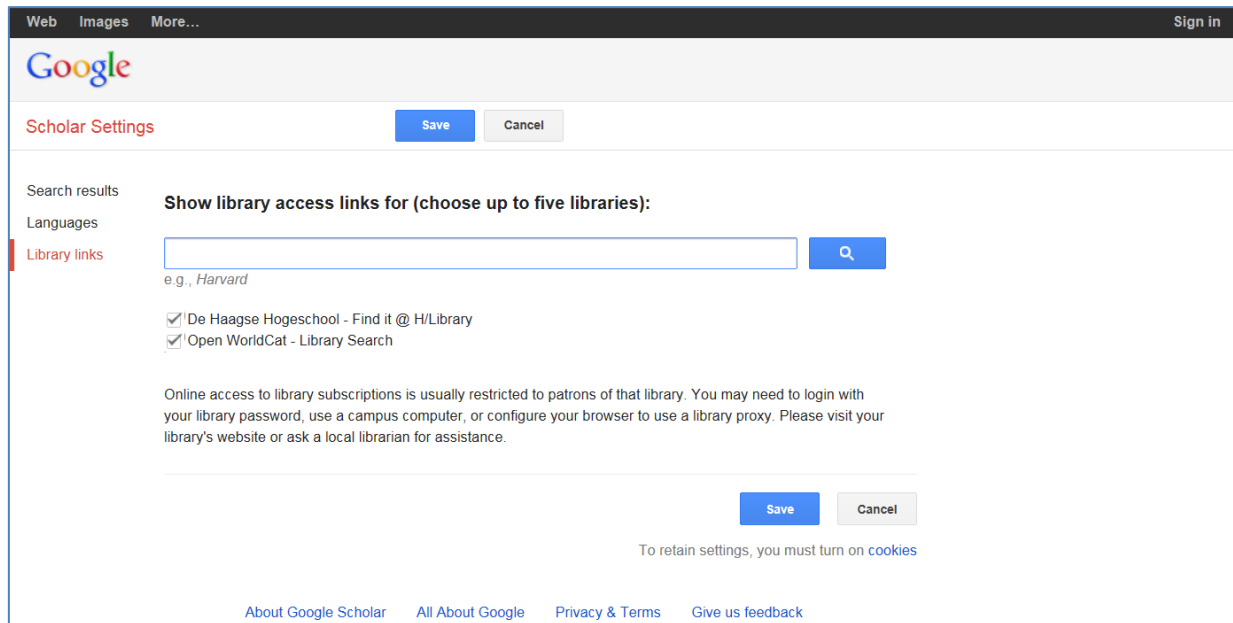


Figure 1 – Saving your personal settings in Google Scholar

The link to **Find it** will be shown automatically if you use Google Scholar on-campus (or if you log in through <http://ezproxy.hhs.nl:2048/login?url=http://scholar.google.nl> off-campus).

Click on **Find it** and you will be taken straight to the full text if **Find it** is displayed to the right of the results screen. If the **Find it** button is shown underneath the record, clicking on it will open the options menu.

Example search in Google Scholar

A search is made using the search terms “Internet AND youth” in Google Scholar. The **Find it** link is shown in the right-hand column next to the first search result in Google Scholar.

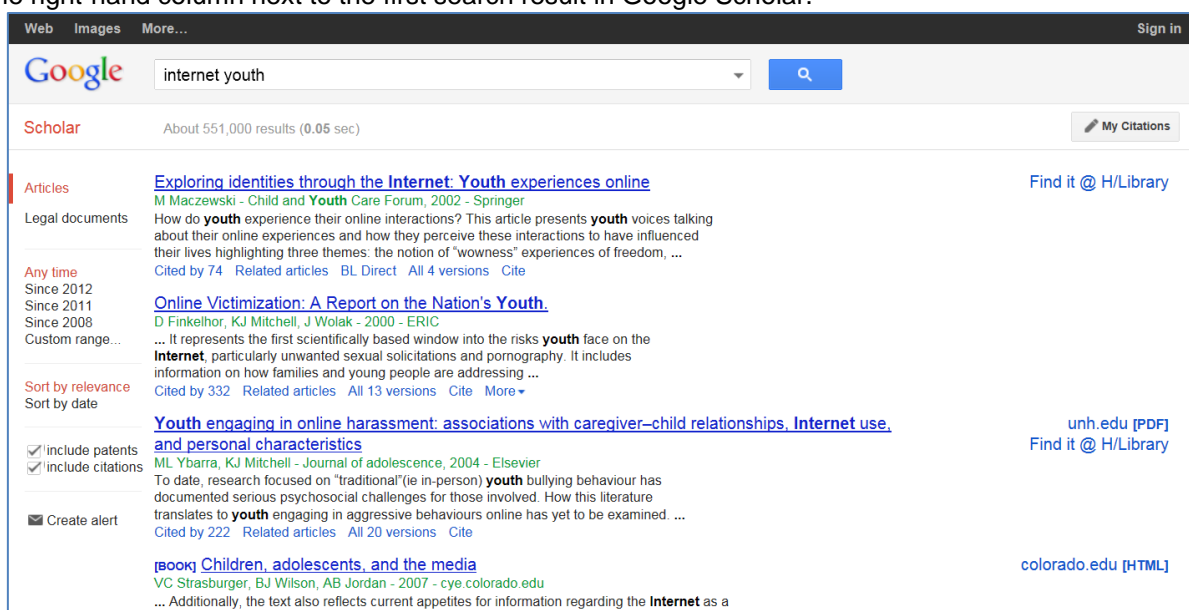


Figure 2 – Search results with references to Find it @ H/Library

Click on it to open the full text of the article.




For articles not immediately available in full text, the link to **Find it** is shown underneath the search result, and you can click on it to continue your search, submit an Interlibrary loan request or make use of citation tools, as in the third record.

Example search in [Sociological Abstracts](#)

A search is made of the bibliographical database “Sociological Abstracts” using the search terms “Internet AND youth”.

The list of search results will feature the green Find it @ H/Library button.

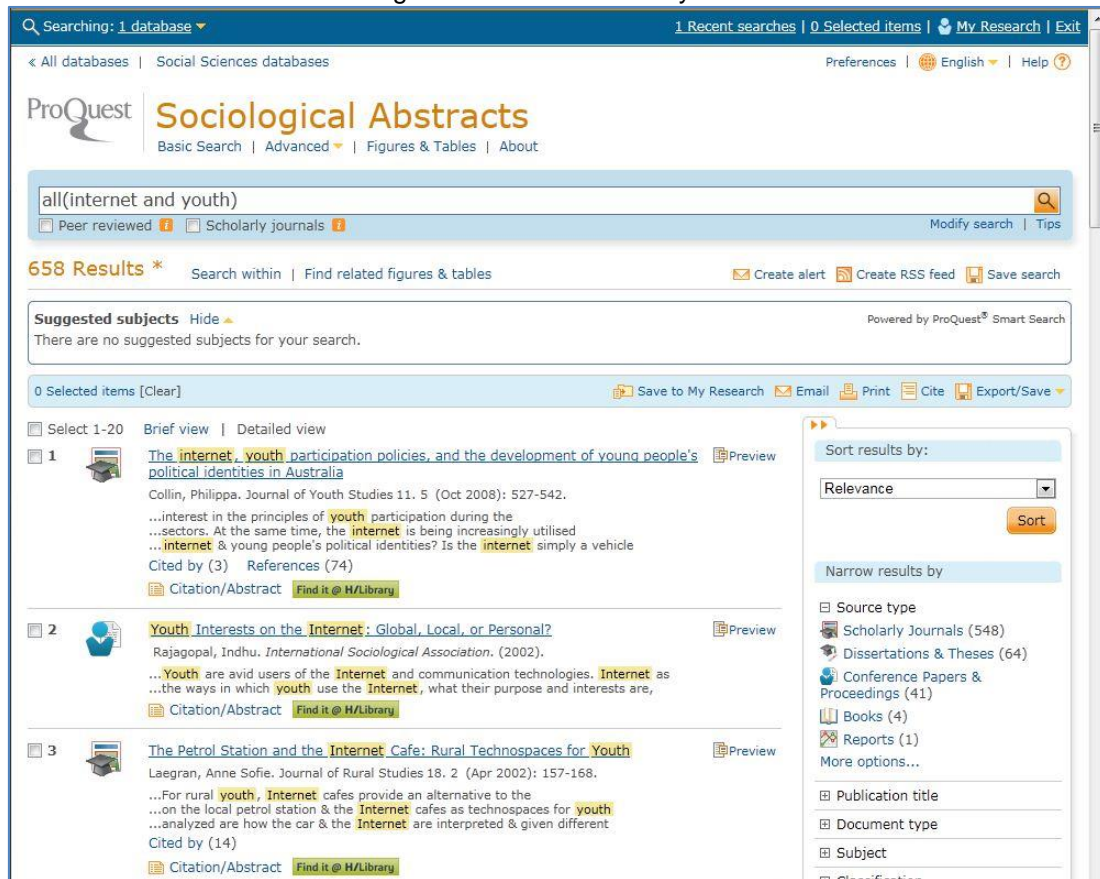


Figure 4 – List of search results featuring references to Find it @ H/Library

Press the “Find it @ H/Library” button in the first record, and you will be taken straight to the full-text article.

The article is shown in a **Find it** frame, which has a “Click for more options” link in the top right-hand corner to take you to the **Find it** menu.

As shown below, a more detailed menu appears if you click on the **Find it** button next to an article that is not available in full text.

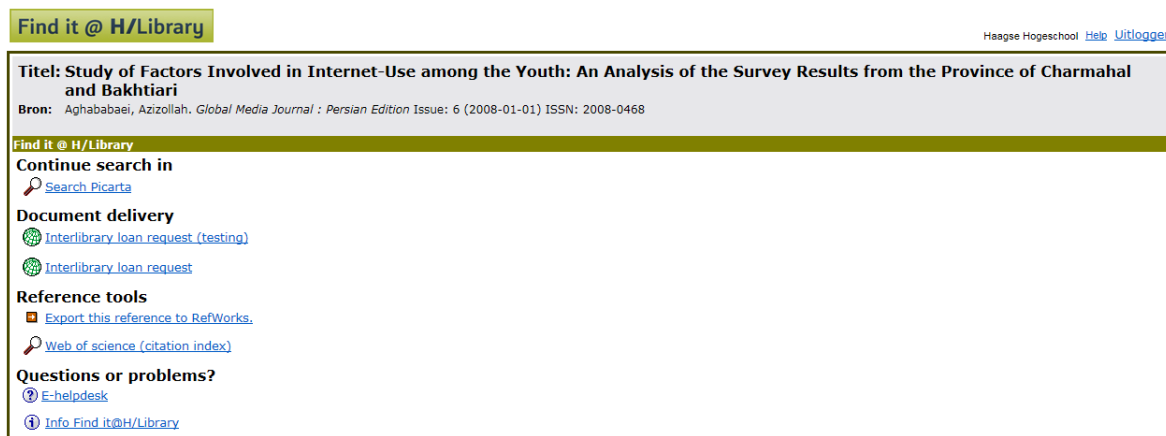


Figure 1 – Menu shown if the full text of the article is not available
