

MASTERS – COSTS FOR FINANCING STUDY AND STAY (non-eea students)

In relation to the application for an entry visa and/or residence permit for the purpose of study, the Dutch Immigration Service (IND) requires proof that you have sufficient funds to pay your tuition fee, support yourself during your entire stay in the Netherlands and pay for relevant costs. Please find in the specifications below which financial means you have to show:

In case you wish to pay your tuition fees in instalments, you need to transfer a down payment of at least € 3000,- before 15 June 2019. See the payment options and proof of sufficient funds below. **And be aware of the administrative fee of € 500 when you choose to pay in instalments.** (This fee will be charged in your first invoice sent to you in October.)

Applicants from "risk countries" as identified by the Dutch Immigration and Naturalisation Service (IND) are required to make a package fee payment in order to be admitted at the University. You will be informed about this during your application.

Payments for NON-EEA applicants must be made **before 15 June 2019**.

Payment options:**Option 1: Payment of package fee**

The package fee payment covers all applicable costs, as well as an amount to show you have sufficient means to support yourself for at least one year.

- MFMC students are required to transfer a total amount of € **28.186,-**
- MICM students are required to transfer a total amount of € **28.186,-**
- MBA Regular stream students are required to transfer a total amount of € **31.336,-**
- MBA Responsible management are required to transfer a total amount of € **34.936,-**

After deduction of all costs, the remaining amount will be refunded to your (Dutch) bank account within 4 weeks after receiving bank account details.

Option 2**Transfer the applicable costs and proof that you have the remaining amount available in your own bank account.**

You need to enclose an original bank statement held jointly or solely in your name showing the balance of the amount at your disposal. The statement needs to be an original document with a signature and stamp of the bank and must be in the English language and should at least mention your full name, the account number, the balance in your account, the currency in EURO's and should not be older than 3 months on date of the Immigration Application (June 15th) This original document, after uploaded in OSIRIS, needs to be sent to the International Office.

In case you wish to pay your tuition fees in instalments, your applicable costs consist of the down payment of € 3000, plus the legal and insurance fees. Please also be aware of the administrative fee of € 500 charged by M&PC if you choose to pay in instalments!!!!

Option 3**Transfer the applicable costs and for the remaining amount you are financially supported by a contact person abroad.**

You need to enclose the following documents:

- Financial Guarantee Form.
- Clear and coloured copy of valid passport of your financier;
- Proof that your financier is in a financial position to be able to transfer the money to your personal bank account, for example a recent bank statement and/or account specification showing the bank balance on your financier's account (at least € 10.590,-);

The proof must be one of the following 2 documents:

A: An original bank statement in the name of the financier.

Your financier can withdraw the money from the bank account free of charge and has direct access to the funds. (your financier has for example a current account or a regular savings account that allows him to withdraw cash. Does your financier have a different type of account? Please show that the balance can be withdraw free of charge. Does your financier have a joint account holder? A statement is the required. This statement indicates that your financier may and can use the money.

B: A copy of an account statement. The copy shows the same details as mentioned above, and has the same requirements.

→All statements need to be original documents with a signature and stamp of the bank and must be in the English language and should at least mention your financier's full name, the account number, the balance in the account, the bank details, the currency in EURO's and should not be older than 3 months on the date of the Immigration Application (June 15th)

This original document, after uploaded in OSIRIS, needs to be sent to the International Office by post

Option 4

Transfer the applicable costs and for the remaining amount you are financially supported by a Dutch contact person.

You need to enclose the following documents:

- Financial Guarantee Form.
- Clear and coloured copy of valid passport of your financer;
- An original extract from the municipal administration or BRP (in Dutch this is called "uitreksel bevolkingsregister"), no older than 6 months, demonstrating your financer's residential address and family composition;
- Proof that your financer is in a financial position to be able to transfer the money to your personal bank account, for example a recent bank statement and/or account specification showing the bank balance on your financer's account (at least € 10.590,-).

The statement needs to be an original document with a signature and stamp of the bank and must be in the English language and should at least mention your financer's full name, the account number, the balance in the account, the currency in EURO's and should not be older than 3 months on the date of the Immigration Application (June 15th) This original document, after uploaded in OSIRIS, needs to be sent to the International Office by post.

Option 5

You have been awarded a grant or scholarship.

You need to enclose original proof of grant/scholarship in which the following information is mentioned:

- The name of the company/organization paying the scholarship
 - The name of the company/organization granting the scholarship
 - The start- and end date of your scholarship
 - The monthly amount that will be awarded to you in EURO's.
- This statement should not be older than 3 months at the start of the study program.

Option 6

Transfer the applicable costs and for the remaining amount you are financially supported by a company.

You need to enclose the following documents:

- Financial Guarantee Form.
- An original statement from the company abroad, in which they declare which amount of money will be transferred to your personal bank account on a monthly basis during your stay in The Netherlands;
- Proof that the person who signed the Financial Guarantee Form is in a position, and has access to the financial means of the company. (Statement by the bank)
- Proof that this company is in a financial position to be able to transfer the money to your personal bank account, for example a recent bank statement and/or account specification showing the bank balance on your financer's account (at least € 10.590,-).

The statement needs to be an original document with a signature and stamp of the bank and must be in the English language and should at least mention your financer's full name, the account number, the balance in the account, the currency in EURO's and should not be older than 3 months on the date of the Immigration Application (June 15th)

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
