When and where do we welcome you?

If you are attending the *Intro Camp*, for which you should have already received information, please be in the Atrium (the main area right inside the entrance of the school) at **10:00 on Tuesday, 28 August 2018**. If you won't be with us for the *Intro Camp*, then the first required day here is on **Thursday, 30 August 2018, at 8:45**. This means that you should arrive a bit early to find your way to the correct room and be prepared to start the year on time. Some of you may not be used to starting your day so early, especially after a summer vacation.

You will receive more specific information later in the summer about the activities that day.

Introduction

At our *Intro Day* on **Thursday, 30 August**, you will have an opportunity to meet the lecturers in SSMS, and learn about what we expect of you as students and what you can expect from us teachers and administrators. You will also have a chance to meet and get to know the other students in the first year of the programme. Additionally, there will be a panel of students from years 2 and above who can offer you advice about how to be successful in the programme, and they will answer any questions that you have.

There will also be an introduction to our internal communication system, and our grading and exam registration system.
